Almond Grove Mobile Estates began construction of a new automated gate without the proper permits or any consultation with Escalon Fire. As it was brought to our attention, we immediately sought out information into the project. Housing and Community Development (HCD), which oversees Mobile Home Parks, was notified, and sent an investigator to inspect the construction site. The project was shut down until the owner, Harmony Communities, obtains the proper permits. Hula's fire protection system was red tagged by Nor Cal Fire and is currently being updated. We are working directly with Nor Cal and Hula's to bring them up to code.
