We are in the process of getting things together for Fill the Boots for Burns on May 14th and 15th.

- a. There were 4 new business applications submitted for the month of February. The Smoke Shop on Jackson Ave is a change of ownership and not a new business. A new Mexican style bakery is open at the Plaza, Debby's Gourmet will be opening in March at the corner of Stanislaus and Hwy 120, and Trailer Park'd Coffee will be establishing a mobile coffee service adjacent to Heritage Church.
Almond Grove Mobile Estates began construction of a new automated gate without the proper permits or any consultation with Escalon Fire. As it was brought to our attention, we immediately sought out information into the project. Housing and Community Development (HCD), which oversees Mobile Home Parks, was notified, and sent an investigator to inspect the construction site. The project was shut down until the owner, Harmony Communities, obtains the proper permits.
Hula's fire protection system was red tagged by Nor Cal Fire and is currently being updated. We are working directly with Nor Cal and Hula's to bring them up to code.

Training Division and Reserve/Volunteer Program

The probationary training has been completed for our three new Reserve/Volunteers. They have been approved to start working shifts. (We are still waiting on turnouts for two of them. Supply lines are very slow)

The Fire Investigation series will begin in May.

Fill the Boot for Burns has been scheduled for May 14th and 15th. This will be the first time since COVID that we have been able to get back to this program.

We have three potential candidates in backgrounds to become reserve/volunteers. They are currently finishing up the Modesto Fire Academy.

Prevention

Weed Abatement: March was spent identifying properties that will require weed abatement. 24 "Notice to Destroy Weeds" were issued on March 30, 2022 to county property owners and 16 addresses were forwarded to the City for enforcement. This is the first of the three required steps to force abatement.

Follow up will begin on April 17th and a second notice will be distributed to non-compliant owners.

Permits. Two businesses applied for business licenses due to a change in ownership.

Two applicants applied for variances to building plans. Neither offered any additional fire risk and were granted variances from the Fire Department.
